# Get Prepared Now for 2019-20 AP Changes

Dear District Leaders,

We've recently shared important updates about the changes coming to AP® in 2019-20. Below is a summary of the updates and a list of resource links that were emailed to your district's principals and AP coordinators.

## Next Steps

- **Back-to-school plan:** Schools will need to take a few key steps at the beginning of the year to access the new classroom resources and enable students to register for AP Exams. Schools should review the new guides for AP [coordinators](#) (.pdf/561 KB), [teachers](#) (.pdf/705 KB), and [students](#) (.pdf/1.03 MB) and begin planning how they'll ensure all AP students enroll online when classes begin.
- **Free training resources and events:** AP [coordinators](#) (.pdf/487 KB) and [teachers](#) (.pdf/508 KB) have access to a wide range of free informational events and self-guided resources. Encourage your staff to take advantage of them.
- **Access codes:** Principals and AP coordinators should look for their school's access code, which they'll receive via email and in the mail starting August 1. Coordinators will use this code to set up the AP Registration and Ordering system.
